CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Check with the financial aid office or go to college websites for a listing of college/university and departmental scholarships.

Scholarships are posted in order of the due date.

New scholarships included since the last posting are highlighted below.

<u>Corporation</u> <u>for Ohio Appalachian Development (COAD) David V. Stivison Appalachian Scholarship</u> - must be a resident of COAD's service area for at least one year prior to the application deadline and reside in household with total annual income at or below 200% the federal poverty guidelines. Proof of acceptance at a 2 year or 4 year institution is required. Applications available at www.coadinc.org/scholarships or in guidance. All applicants must submit all application forms and required documentation directly to the local Community Action Agency that serves the county where the applicant resides. **Deadline: April 1, 2017 (postmarked)**

<u>Washington</u> <u>County</u> <u>Farm</u> <u>Bureau</u> <u>Scholarship</u> - \$2,000 scholarship. Parents, grandparents or guardian of applicant must have been a Farm Bureau member for three years or more, must have a 2.5 gpa or higher, enrolled in a two or four year program. Applications available at washington.ofbf.org. Must be typed and complete! **Deadline: April 1, 2017**

<u>Marietta Community Foundation</u> <u>Scholarships</u> <u>(continued)</u> - This group of MCF scholarships all require an application (available in the guidance office).

*Note for each of the following MCF scholarships: **Deadline: April 1, 2016**

Kevin O'Brien Kelly Memorial Scholarship - awarded to a Marietta High School senior planning to continue his/her education at Ohio University. MHS graduates currently attending OU may also apply. Must have a minimum 2.5 gpa to qualify. This award may be used to obtain an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree and is renewable for four years. **Deadline: April 3, 2017**

<u>Danny Dutton Athletic Memorial Scholarship</u> – Open to MHS seniors who participate in baseball and have minimum 2.0 gpa. Scholarship promise, financial need and an individual who puts team values/goals ahead of individual accolades.

Deadline: April 1, 2016

Edward Parrish Chapter Colonial Dames XVII Century Scholarship – Requires a 500 word essay on a person who lived in America between 1600 and 1701 whose character traits you admire and explain how you could relate to them and an essay no longer than one page discussing your involvement in your community and your volunteer work.

<u>John McCracken Memorial</u> <u>Scholarship</u> – Requires an essay of no more than one page discussing your involvement in your community, volunteer work, and your leadership ability and how you have taken a leadership role in your school/community and a list of your extra-curricular activities with years and offices held.

<u>Mark C. Studenic Memorial Scholarship</u> - \$500 to a student who would like to continue his/her education in the fields of science, technical, engineering or math. Must have a minimum 2.0 gpa. May be used for Associate's Degree, Vocational Training, or Adult Education courses. An essay no longer than one page discussing involvement in community, volunteer work, and post-secondary plans is required.

<u>Stanton W. Brock Memorial Scholarship</u> – \$1,000 – Senior who would like to continue his/her education by going to an art school. Demonstrated art talent and who will study art to become a

more accomplished artist and intends to make art a vocation. 300 word essay and a list of extra-curricular activities during high school required. Applications available in guidance.

<u>Thomas Vadakin Memorial Scholarship</u> – Awarded to a current senior or previous graduate of MHS. Must be pursuing a career in the engineering or business fields and have a minimum 3.0 gpa. An essay no longer than one page discussing involvement in community, volunteer work, and post-secondary plans is required.

<u>Faustena</u> <u>"Frosty" Haas Health Care Scholarship Fund</u> – available to any post-secondary student studying health care; however, greater weight will be given to students studying direct patient care, oncology, nursing, radiology, or chemotherapy.

Edwin "Jack" Haas Memorial Scholarship – open to any qualified individual who would like to continue his/her technical education in the fields of electronics, electrical, welding, pipe fitting, HVAC, fabrication, machinist or other approved technical training programs. Must have a minimum 2.0 GPA. This scholarship may be used to obtain any post-secondary degree, vocational training, or Adult Education courses, with greater weight placed on community colleges & technical programs.

<u>Carpe Diem Athletic & Academic Scholarship</u> – Awarded to a graduating senior from MHS who has a minimum 3.0 cumulative gpa and is planning to attend a 2 or 4 year accredited college or university. The applicant needs to have participated successfully in an area of athletics at MHS, using well the skills of a sport, showing team leadership, unselfishness, and sportsmanship on the playing surface.

Bee You Scholarship - Open to any senior In Washington County, OH or Wood County, WV who has experienced bullying personally or have taken steps to resolve a situation involving bullying. A 500 word essay on your experience with bullying is required. Must be pursuing further education at an accredited technical college, 4-year college, or university (no specific curriculum required).

<u>Charlie Spindler Athletic Memorial Scholarship</u> – \$500 awarded to a Marietta High School Boys Basketball player who leads by example. Eligible applicants must be current seniors of MHS, participate in MHS basketball, have a minimum 3.0 gpa, and plan on pursuing a post-high school degree at an accredited institution.

<u>James S. and Brenda A. Measell Scholarship</u> - \$500 scholarship. Must have a minimum 3.5 gpa continuing education at an accredited 4 year college or university pursuing a Bachelor's Degree. Open to graduates or graduating seniors of a Washington County School.

<u>J. William Morris Scholarship</u> - applicants must have demonstrated and specified an interest in achieving a business administration, accounting or finance degree. Renewable for up to three years.

Art Fordham Memorial Scholarship - This \$1,500 non-renewable scholarship is to be awarded to graduating high school seniors attending MHS or the Washington County Career Center. This scholarship may be used to obtain an Associate's Degree, Vocational training, or Adult Education courses. A transcript, written essay not to exceed one page, and three letters of recommendation are required.

<u>Dr. Richard Hille Memorial Scholarship for Medical Students</u> – Applicants must have graduated from a Washington County High School, attended an undergraduate college in Ohio, and be enrolled in Medical School in Ohio. Preference will be given to those in Family Medicine. Must have a 3.0 gpa. An essay no longer than one page discussing involvement in community, volunteer work, and future plans and another describing how this scholarship will assist you financially.

<u>United Producers</u> <u>Inc.</u> – Offering up to 18 - \$1,000 scholarships – applicants must be a preferred member of UPI or a child or grandchild of a preferred member. Must be a 2017 graduating high school senior enrolled in a college or technical school, studying an agriculture-related field. Essay of 500-1,000 words is required. <u>The Shelly Company Scholarship</u> - \$500 scholarship to a student at MHS who has a minimum 3.0 gpa. Transcript, typed essay, letter of recommendation, & letter of acceptance required. Applications available in guidance. **Deadline: April 1, 2017**

<u>Marshall University Alumni Scholarship</u> - \$1,000 scholarship. Parent or grandparent of applicant must have been an alumni of Marshall University for the applicant to qualify.

Postmark deadline: April 3, 2017

Primary consideration is given to a properly completed application and community service as well as financial need, academic achievement, and acceptance at an accredited college or technical school. <u>Marietta Noon Rotary Club Scholarship</u> - Awards \$500-\$2,000. **Postmark deadline:** April 4, 2017

<u>George Edward "Ted" Chapman Memorial Scholarship</u> - Scholarships will be awarded in amounts from \$500-\$1,000. Applicant must be going into the fields of ART, COMPUTERS or MUSIC to qualify. **Postmark deadline: April 4, 2017**

William D. Squires Educational Foundation, Inc. – Awards fifteen (15) \$3,000 renewable scholarships! Only available to seniors from Ohio. Financial need based (EFC from FAFSA must be under 8,000). Applicant must have a specific career goal, be highly motivated, have good character, and show academic promise - minimum GPA 3.20. For an application, go to www.wmdsquiresfoundation.org Applications accepted starting February 15th until the deadline.

<u>Ohio Valley Community Credit Union</u> - awarding four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to a member or a student of a member in good standing. Must have a 2.8 gpa or higher. One of the scholarships is the Kathie Bayes Scholarship, which is only available to students pursuing a degree in business. Applications available in guidance. **Deadline: April 7, 2017**

<u>OhioLEADS!</u> <u>Scholarships</u> – Applies only to specific career colleges and schools such as ITT Tech. Must have a "C" or better grade point average, be nominated by a local civic or community leader or by a current member of the Ohio Legislature, and meet the school's entrance requirements. Not need based. Please go on-line at <u>www.ohiocareercolleges.org</u> or see your counselor for the list of colleges/institutes and an application.

Deadline: April 14, 2017

American Association of Drilling Engineers - Awards (20) \$1,000 scholarships with the possibility of applying for (3) \$2,000 renewable scholarships after a successful freshman year in college. The total potential AADE aid could amount to \$7,000 over 4 years. Must have a high school GPA of 3.5 or above, scored a minimum 27 on ACT (or 600 Math and 600 Critical Reading on SAT), and be enrolled in college in PA, OH, or WV. <u>J. Bryan</u> and <u>Norma R. McCann Scholarship</u> - Available for all four years of college to students who qualify by completing and submitting the application and all attachments requested. Amounts awarded based on need and student academic record.

Must have cumulative 2.0 gpa or higher and be enrolled in the law enforcement college program by July 31, 2017. Essay of 500 words or less is required. **Deadline: April** 28,2017
